

ALLIED Membership Structure



Student Advancement

Must be an active student member at time of graduation and advance within six months from graduation

Receives discounted dues rates on a six year progression scale to dues amount that matches Allied member. Legislative assessment is waived during first 2 years of membership

Allied Membership

Either joins ASID for the first time or is a lapsed former student member.

Must submit transcript demonstrating a minimum of 40 semester hours in Interior Design. First two years of Allied membership have the same dues rate but third, fourth and fifth years have progressive increases. Must pay legislative assessment.

Special Allied statuses

Allied International: principal business & residence are outside the boundaries of established ASID chapter. Receive one level of membership dues.

Allied Educator: Full time status as educator in a post-secondary program of interior design education at a university of accredited school of interior design. Receive one level of membership dues. Must pay leg assessment.

Allied Leave of Absence: One time only for up to three years. May not use the appellation while on Leave of Absence. Member dues are 50% of the annual dues. Must pay leg assessment.

This member will not show an appellation in their database record and must reapply each year for the status up to three years

PROFESSIONAL Membership Structure



Professional Practitioner

Must pass the NCIDQ exam and provide ASID with NCIDQ certificate number.

- Flat dues rate upon becoming Professional member. Must pay legislative assessment.
- Dues waiver of one years dues for Allied members in good standing who pass NCIDQ and notify headquarters within year of passing with NCIDQ certificate number.

Professional Educator

Successful completion of NCIDQ and full time status as instructor

Receive discount level of membership dues

Professional Inactive

May not practice interior design while on this status. Retains use of appellation

- This status must be renewed annually but there is no time limit.
- Receives discounted membership rate.
- Must pay leg assessment

Professional Retired

- At least 65 years of age.
- Member of ASID for at least 20 years
- No longer practicing

- Must pay leg assessment. Automatically renewed at this level – no need to reapply.
- May continue to use the appellation

Industry Partners Membership Structure



Category 1

Receive 49 slots for their membership dues. Additional slots may be purchased for \$150 each

Large national companies make up the bulk of Category 1 members

Category 2

Receive 2 slots for their base membership dues. Additional slots may be purchased for \$150 each

This category is comprised of regional companies or several reps from a national company

Category 3

Receive 1 slot for their membership dues. May add **one** additional slot for \$150 but only one person can be on this membership

This category is comprised of local companies who want access to their local chapter.

Student

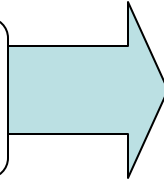
Enrolled in an interior design or architecture program that requires at least 40 semester hours of interior design education to graduate.

Membership Status

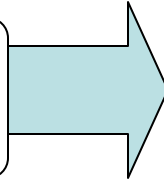


PENDING



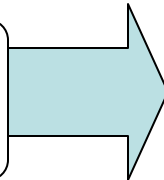
We have received an application and are waiting on a) a transcript b) an NCIDQ number or c) payment.

DENIED



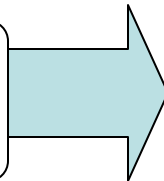
We have denied the application. This may be because: a) the transcript did not reflect the required number of hours of interior design education b) we did not receive a transcript from the applicant within 90 days or c) we did not receive an NCIDQ number from the applicant.

ACTIVE



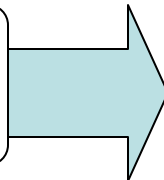
This member is in good standing with the Society. A member who has not paid dues for the current year will remain active until suspensions take place (mid April).

SUSPENDED



This member has an outstanding balance on their record and is no longer active. This person will not come up on active member reports or counts of membership. The member remains on “suspended” status until the end of the current membership year. We refer to this status as “terminated” when speaking with members.

TERMINATED



This member was on suspended status and has now moved past the membership year in which they did not pay full balance. For practitioners to reinstate they must pay \$150 reinstatement fee and prorated dues for current year. IP or students in this category must reapply but do not have a reinstatement fee.
